Retinal Photography

Dear Patient,

A highly sophisticated digital camera allows us to provide a more thorough medical analysis of your eye. The retinal imaging system takes photographs of the retina (the inside of your eye). This procedure assists the doctor in the early detection of many disorders, including glaucoma, diabetic retinopathy, macular degeneration, and other vision threatening conditions. The photos will become part of your medical records for comparison with photos from future exams. This allows the doctor to observe even the smallest amount of change from previous examinations.

We highly recommend that our patients have retinal photography performed. It is especially important for people who have:

1. Headaches
2. Spots or flashes in vision
3. Diabetes
4. High blood pressure
5. A family history of glaucoma, diabetes and/or high blood pressure
6. High cholesterol
7. Never been examined in our office
8. Reached the age of 40 and have not had baseline photos previously.

There is an additional fee for this procedure of \$30.00*. In certain cases, where a diagnosis is made, your medical insurance may help cover the cost. Vision insurance plans do not cover retinal photography. Please check the appropriate line below and sign at the bottom.
